

re: WD Finals 2017

Conditions of play for all Finals matches:

The teams that are venues for finals are responsible for providing markers for the games, recording results, arranging for competition balls, clocks, preparation of tables, etc (*This does not apply to Blacktown Workers Div 2 team as they are playing away that night*).

Teams to be ready to play by 7pm or earlier. This earlier start allows for some extra time in the case of a draw.

That part of ByLaw 5 that permits a player to "double up" is not applicable to the finals series.

Players must be qualified - see ByLaw 4). A list of qualified players is available on this page.

If the finals result in a draw, then ByLaw 30 will apply. Ensure a new result sheet is used.

If a draw still results after this then a billiards "shootout" will occur where each captain selects a player. This player plays with 3 balls on the table - red on the red spot, yellow on the diamond spot and white in hand. The player will endeavour to make a break. Their opponent will, once there is no further score, will also try to make a break. The highest score wins. If no winner, then repeat until there is a winner. A toss of a coin will determine the order of play.

The room organiser (usually the captain of the team whose venue is being used) is responsible for recording results and promptly forwarding the result sheet to the match secretary.
